PROJECT EAT

The Junior League of Detroit Project EAT initiative connects food Education, Access, and Tools to help families eat healthy meals together. Project EAT was created in 2012 to help address food insecurity in the city of Detroit. Together, with our community partner, Humble Design, we assemble and donate 'Kitchen Kits' to provide families with the tools to prepare a healthy home cooked meal every day. Over 400 kits have been distributed so far.



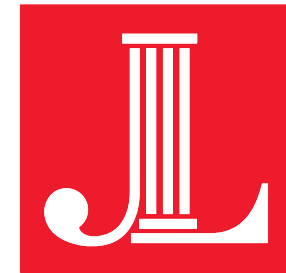
DESIGNERS' SHOW HOUSE

The biennial Designers' Show House serves as the signature fundraiser for the Junior League of Detroit. It takes advantage of the area's fabulous architecture and top-notch design community to transform a local home into a "show house" for the public to enjoy for several weeks. Since our first Designers' Show House, in 1976, over \$4.5 Million has been raised through the event to help fund the JLD's many community based projects and programs.

The Holiday Jubilee is a seasonal fundraiser held on our non-show house years. The theme of the event changes from year to year, however the goal remains the same - to raise money to support one of our many community impact initiatives or contribute to one of our community agencies.
