PROJECT EAT

The Junior League of Detroit established Project EAT as a way to connect food Education, Access, and Tools to help families eat healthy meals together. The Junior League of Detroit has partnered with Humble Design to create 'Kitchen Kits' that provide families with the tools to prepare a healthy home cooked meal every day. The JLD has distributed over 400 Kitchen Kits since 2014.



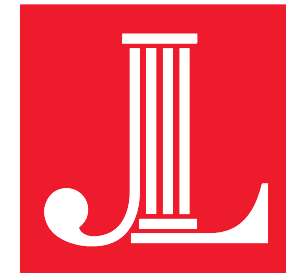
DESIGNERS' SHOW HOUSE

The biennial Designers' Show House serves as the signature fundraiser for the Junior League of Detroit. It takes advantage of the area's fabulous architecture and top-notch design community to transform a local home into a "show house" for the public to enjoy for several weeks. Since our first Designers' Show House in 1976 over \$4 Million has been raised through the event to help fund the JLD's many community based projects and programs.



HOLIDAY JUBILEE

The Holiday Jubilee is a seasonal fundraiser held on our non-show house years. The theme of the event changes from year to year, however the goal remains the same - to raise money to support one of our community impact initiatives or contribute to one of our community agencies - most recently the Cass Community Social Service's Tiny House project.
