Built in 1988, this luxurious manor-style home is set within Grosse Pointe Farms on the highest point on Lake Shore Road. It is without doubt, a sophisticated, gently opulent and finely crafted jewel.

"It's always an amazing transformation, and a testament to the talent and hard work of the designers who take this transformation on, said JLD President Kimberly Burke. "What we always keep in mind is that all these efforts support very important causes. This year our JLD projects benefit Brilliant Detroit and Alternatives For Girls. The JLD Designers' Show House season includes the Sneak-a-Peek weekend event July 13-15. Event hours are: 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Friday, July 15; from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Saturday, July 16; and from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Sunday, July 17.
